ABOUT THE FACILITY



The Tennessee Miller Coliseum is a 22+ million dollar facility that is located just 30 minutes South of Nashville. Situated on 154 acres, the 222,000 square foot complex boasts a state-of-the-art, climate controlled 150' x 300' main arena with an attached 120' x 200' warm-up arena, as well as a large outdoor ring. Exhibitors have access to an additional indoor arena for warm up during the evening performances, totalling 3 warm up areas. The stable features 500 10' x 10' stalls with accessible power and water, wash racks, manure bins, shoeing area, restrooms with showers, and a covered walkway from the main barn to the arena. All stalls and aisleways are blacktop/paved. There are 117 camper hookups with power and water and a dump station on the grounds.

Who is CJ du Plessis?

United States judges have been going to South Africa to mark the cards at their National Championships for over 25 years. World Cup equitation competitions are adjudicated by multinational panels, but our performance shows have not hired outside of our US licensed judging pool. Southern Saddlebred is excited about changing that!



"I judged the SA National Championship in 2010 with CJ," said James Hale. "I know him to be a good, honest, fair judge and a talented horseman. We wanted to do something different - to look outside the box when it came to selecting a judge for our show - and CJ was my first choice." Jackie added, "He is a regular spectator at the KSF World's Championship Horse Show and we will insure that he is apprised of class specifications and standards that may differ from those in South Africa, just as the US judges are instructed prior to judging there. We are thrilled that he accepted our invitation and he is excited about opening the door for other SA Judges to follow. I have no doubt he will do an excellent job."

As a fifth generation horseman and the third generation in the Saddlebred fraternity, CJ is living his passion and dream of breeding, training and showing horses in South Africa and abroad as well as judging at local and international shows.

In 1965, CJ's father, Charel Johannes bought a Saddlebred filly "Special Serenity" for the amount of R1 400; at the time it was an enormous price to pay for a horse. This filly would ultimately become the foundation of Saddlebred horses born on the family farm, Ruigtevlei, near Bethulie in the Free State in South Africa, where CJ and his family focus mainly on producing sheep, cattle and goats.

After University, both CJ and his brother Kosie, also an accomplished rider and trainer, spent time in the USA. CJ spent a year working in the States and also at Silver Brook Stables in Louisville, Kentucky. In 1993 CJ took over the breeding and showing program of the SA Saddle Horses at Ruigtevlei.

CJ became a judge in 2002, and has since judged the South African National Championships in Bloemfontein on three occasions and has also judged the South African Hackney Pony Championships on a number of occasions. He has also officiated as a judge at the major shows in Namibia. CJ is also the Chairperson of the Judge's Association in South Africa.

Ruigtevlei is synonymous with champions. The Du Plessis brothers believe in quality over quantity and select only the best stallions to breed with. South African champions bred and exhibited by the du Plessis brothers include Uncle Angus, Make A Brake, Mr. Freedom Hall, Mr. Mojive, the exceptional mare Miss Gracias, Song of Grace, Miss Shelbyville and most recently, Something French, winner of the Fine Harness Mare class at Bloemfontein in April, 2019.

\$25 of the the stall fees is designated for the Trainer's Jackpot. Trainers who get their entries in by the deadline of Oct. 1st will be eligible for the money. (Entries must be postmarked 10/1 or received via email by midnight.) The trainer of the highest placing eligible entry in each Championship or Stake class will pick up cash at the out gate! Payout depends on the number of stalls sold, but it has been about \$200/ class. **So enter on time!**

RULES AND REGULATIONS

- 1. PAYMENT: No entries will be accepted and no stalls reserved unless accompanied by payment in full for stall and entry fees. An open check is acceptable. Non-Stalled horses will be charged a \$20/day grounds fee.
- 2. REFUNDS: In case of horses being entered and not exhibited, the stall fees are NOT REFUNDABLE after closing date unless they can be rented to someone else. Entry fees will be refunded.
- 3. ENTRIES: Closing date for entries is October 1. The word "Entry" will not be accepted. Each entry blank must contain the name and full description of each horse or pony and the class in which it is to be entered. Any entries not paid in full or received after the closing date, except stake and championship classes, will be considered Post Entries. *Post Entries will be accepted at a \$10.00 additional charge per horse.*
- 4. POST ENTRIES: Post entries will be accepted during regular office hours. Emergency Post Entries will be accepted in the Paddock at a \$25.00 additional charge per class.
- 5. SCRATCHES: All scratches must be made 2 hours prior to show time.
- 6. DAMAGES: All owners and exhibitors will be held responsible for any damage incurred by them or their agents to barns or other properties on the showgrounds, and will be charged accordingly.
- 7. STALLS: Stalls will be available from Monday, October 15th at 6pm through Sunday, October 21st at Noon for \$135 per stall. No stalls will be reserved unless accompanied by entries and payment in full for both stalls and entries. An open check is acceptable. There are 500 permanent stalls available and will be assigned on a first-come, first-serve basis with consideration give to previous attendance and sponsorship, at the discretion of show management. Temporary stabling may also be used if necessary. No initial bedding will be supplied. Requests for specific stalls will be considered but not guaranteed. Stall fees are non-refundable after the closing date of entries unless they can be rented to someone else.
- 8. BEDDING: Bedding will be available at \$7.50/bag through the TMC and ordered in the show office. Bedding will be pre-delivered if be ordered in advance on the entry form. You may bring your own bedding, but no outside bedding DELIVERIES allowed. 9. HOLDS: Please place your hold request in advance of each session. Holds will be limited to five (5) minutes. Emergency holds will be accepted by the Paddock Master. 10. RULES: Fall Finale is affiliated with Equine Sports Council and will be governed by their rules and regulations. Horse show rules are available on the website and a hard copy will be available in the office. The show manager will act as steward when any rule needs to be reviewed for clarification.
- 11. HORSES: All horses must be serviceably sound. In case of suspected unsoundness, the Judge may, if he so desires, have the horse examined by the show veterinarian, and his decision will be final. No Exhibitor may use a Veterinarian's Statement to contradict the Judge's decision.

- 12. CAVEATS: The Show Management reserves the right to decline to receive any entry and to return any entry fee and/or stable fee before or during the show, without being liable for compensation. Three entries are necessary to fill a class unless otherwise specified, or the class may be declared void, at the option of the Committee. If the entries in two or more classes of the same division are not sufficient to fill, the committee reserves the right to combine the same into competition.
- 13. LIABILITY: Southern Saddlebred Sales, Inc, the Show Chairmen, Show Manager, the Tennessee Miller Coliseum, nor any volunteer or sponsor will be responsible for any accident or damage which may occur to any owner, rider, driver, groom, attendant, animal, or equipment at the show. Each rider exhibits at their own risk and agrees to hold harmless any other exhibitors or trainers for any accident or injury.

WARNING: Under Tennessee Law, an equine activity sponsor or equine professional is not liable for an injury to, or death of a participant in equine activities, pursuant to Tennessee Code Annotated Title 44, Ch. 20, Part 1.

- 14. SHOW RING: No person will be allowed in the show ring during the time of judging except the exhibitors and those having official or requested duties to perform. No horse will be allowed in the show ring except at such hours as posted in the show office.
- 15. DISCIPLINE: Exhibitors are notified that any act of discourtesy or disobedience to the judge or officials, on the part of the owner, manager, rider, driver, or groom shall be grounds to disqualify the horse, and the owner shall forfeit his entry fee and other fees. In the case of any horse being disqualified, the winner of the next succeeding prize in that class shall take the prize that had been awarded to such disqualified horse.
- 16. DISPUTES: Should any question arise that is not provided for in these rules, the same shall be referred to the Show Manager/Steward whose decision shall be final.
- 17. DRESS: All riders, drivers, attendants, and grooms shall be neatly and appropriately dressed upon entering the ring.
- 18. PETS: Pets must remain on leash at all times and are the owner's responsibility.
- 19. NEGATIVE COGGINS: A valid negative Coggins test within one year of the show must accompany each horse and must be available for inspection.
- 20. PARKING: All trucks, vans, trailers, and RVs, after unloading, must park in the designated parking area.
- 21. CHECKS: All checks should be made payable to Southern Saddlebred. Returned checks will incur a \$50.00 handling fee. No one will be allowed to show who has a bad check or handling fee outstanding.
- 22. RING PROCEDURES: The gate to the show ring will remain open two minutes after the first horse enters the ring, after which the gate will be closed. Any exhibitor not in the ring by that time will not be admitted. Please cooperate by being on time. Due to unfore-seeable problems with any mechanical device, the PA system and paddock calls over that system must be considered a courtesy. Therefore, no protest will be upheld, nor will any section be changed due to a PA malfunction.
- 23. CAMPERS: 117 Camper hookups are available for \$35.00 per night and paid for in the show office.
- 24. GOLF CARTS: Golf carts are to be operated only by a licensed driver.
- 25. STABLE AREA: Gas, electric or propane heaters, propane tanks and hot plates are prohibited in the stable area. All electrical extension cords must be 12 gauge, 3 wire and prong negative type.
- 26. NO SMOKING IN ANY BUILDING, RESTROOM OR STABLE ON GROUNDS!
